SURFACE PREPARATIONS Use

Use in accordance with the standard Worldwide Marine Specifications. All surfaces to be coated should be clean, dry and free from contamination. High pressure fresh water wash or fresh water wash, as appropriate, and remove all oil or grease, soluble

contaminants and other foreign matter in accordance with SSPC-SP1 solvent cleaning.

Consult your International Paint representative for the system best suited for the surfaces to be protected.

#### NEWBUILDING/MAJOR REFURBISHMENT

Interswift 455FB should always be applied over a recommended primer coating scheme. The primer surface should be dry and free from all contamination, and Interswift 455FB must be applied within the overcoating intervals specified (consult the relevant product data sheet).

Areas of breakdown, damage etc. should be prepared to the specified standard (eg. Sa2½ (ISO 8501-1:2007)) and primed prior to the application of Interswift 455FB.

#### REPAIR

Application of Interswift 455FB over self:

Clean the entire area with close high pressure fresh water washing using a fan-jet lance held close to the surface (3,000 p.s.i., 211 kg/cm<sup>2</sup>) as soon as the vessel enters dock and before it dries out.

Consult International Paint for alternative methods of surface preparation.

Repair corroded areas with the recommended anticorrosive primer system and apply Interswift 455FB within the overcoating interval specified for the primer (consult relevant primer data sheets).

Application of Interswift 455FB over International Paint TBT-Free, International Paint Intersmooth SPC or competitors antifoulings:

#### LIMITATIONS

FOR FLAT BOTTOM USE ONLY

If the following maximum recommended exposure times before flooding are exceeded, antifouling performance may be impaired

Tropical conditions - 3 months

Temperate conditions - 6 months

If these times are exceeded, close high pressure fresh water wash (at 3,000 p.s.i., 211 kg/cm<sup>2</sup>) the surface before immersion

Overcoating information is given for guidance only and is subject to regional variation depending upon local climate and environmental conditions. Consult your local International Paint representative for specific recommendations. On immersion colours will change

Dark Red -> Light Red/Brown

Brown -> Dark Brown/Black

Interswift 455FB must not be applied directly over tar containing anticorrosives.

At Maintenance & Repair, when overcoating exposed (polish through) areas of tar anticorrosives, a touch-up of Intertuf 203 should be applied prior to the application of Interswift 455FB

Interswift 455FB require additional mixing with a power agitator prior to application. Consult your International Paint representative for specific recommendations.

Apply in good weather. Temperature of the surface to be coated must be at least 3°C above the dew point. For optimum application properties bring the material to 21-27°C, unless specifically instructed otherwise, prior to mixing and application. Unmixed material (in closed containers) should be maintained in protected storage in accordance with information given in the STORAGE Section of this data sheet.
