PREPARATIONS

SURFACE Use in accordance wi

Use in accordance with the standard Worldwide Marine Specifications. All surfaces to be coated should be clean, dry and free from contamination.

High pressure fresh water wash or fresh water wash, as appropriate, and remove all oil or grease, soluble contaminants and other foreign matter in accordance with SSPC-SP1 solvent cleaning.

Consult your International Paint representative for the system best suited for the surfaces to be protected.

MAJOR REFURBISHMENT

Intersmooth 460 SPC should always be applied over a recommended primer coating scheme. The primer surface should be dry and free from all contamination, and Intersmooth 460 SPC must be applied within the overcoating intervals specified (consult the relevant product data sheet).

Areas of breakdown, damage etc. should be prepared to the specified standard (eg. Sa2½ (ISO 8501-1:2007)) and primed prior to the application of Intersmooth 460 SPC.

REPAIR

Application of Intersmooth 460 SPC over self:

Clean the entire area with close high pressure fresh water washing using a fan-jet lance held close to the surface (3,000 p.s.i., 211 kg/cm²) as soon as the vessel enters dock and before it dries out.

Consult International Paint for alternative methods of surface preparation.

Repair corroded areas with the recommended anticorrosive primer system and apply Intersmooth 460 SPC within the overcoating interval specified for the primer (consult relevant primer data sheets).

Application of Intersmooth 460 SPC over International Paint TBT-Free, International Paint Intersmooth SPC or competitors antifoulings:

This material is a one pack coating and should always be mixed thoroughly with a power agitator before application. Mixina

On immersion, Intersmooth 460 SPC will exhibit a slight colour change.

Overcoating information is given for guidance only and is subject to regional variation depending upon local climate and environmental conditions. Consult your local International Paint representative for specific recommendations.
